



Getting to the heart of creativity.

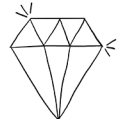
Kimberly Brown facilitates unique events that provide creative, playful and inspiring spaces where students are challenged to think about process, not just outcomes.

This workshop for secondary school students uses art-making to get to the core of creativity by exploring play, risk and notions of self-worth.

the **CLASS**

It begins with interactive, group art making that disrupts expectations about art and workshops, creativity and mistakes. It's followed by conversation and debrief and more artmaking. The outline of each workshop will vary depending on the needs, time frame and desired outcome of any individual school setting, but the basic tenets remain the same: make art in a way that is different, uncomfortable and fun in order to raise questions about play, risk and value (of ourselves and the things we make).

All art materials and supplies are provided, including drop cloths and aprons. The venue must provide appropriate space (access to water and waste water drain), tables, chairs and additional supervision.
